The American Revolution: Children's Book

Your assignment is to create a children's book that tells (and shows) the story of the American Revolution. The goal of this is to take the most essential events leading up to and including the American Revolution and break them down into their most important aspects; however, be sure to keep a careful eye on historical accuracy!

You should include at least 15 of the following major events:

Albany Plan Sons of Liberty Proclamation of 1783
Bunker Hill French and Indian War Boston Massacre
Stamp Act Lexington/Concord Townsend/Navigation Acts
Tea Act Boston Tea Party Coercive/Intolerable Acts
Dec. of Indep. 1st Continental Cong. Stamp Act Congress
Yorktown Treaty of Paris 2nd Continental Congress

Based on the events you choose, you will write a children's book. Keep in mind the format, vocabulary (and explanations), and purpose of most children's books. In addition to an **Introduction** and a **Conclusion**, your book must include at least **Ten** of the following vocabulary words:

Monarch Legislature Parliament
Salutary Neglect Colony Charter
Compact Mercantilism Boycott
Repeal Delegates Common Sense

These children books must be at least **Twelve** pages long, and must include at least **One** illustration for **Ten** of the topics listed above. Illustrations should be your own work and must be colored. Rest assured you will not be assessed on the quality of your art, but on neatness, clarity, and effectiveness of your illustration in supporting your written topics.
