- **Personality** (Definition)
- **Psychoanalytic Theory** (Freud, free association, psychoanalysis, unconscious, id, ego, superego, defense mechanisms [repression, projection, displacement, regression])
- **Neofreudians** (Adler [inferiority complex])
- **Projective Tests** (TAT, Rorschach)
- **Humanistic Theory** (Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs [physiological, safety, love and belongingness, esteem, self-actualization, self-transcendence], Carl Rogers)
- **Social-Cognitive Theory** (Albert Bandura, internal locus of control, external locus of control)
- **Trait Theory** (CANOE – 5 Factor Model [conscientiousness, agreeableness, neuroticism, openness to experience, extraversion])
