

THE AMERICAN DEVOLUTION

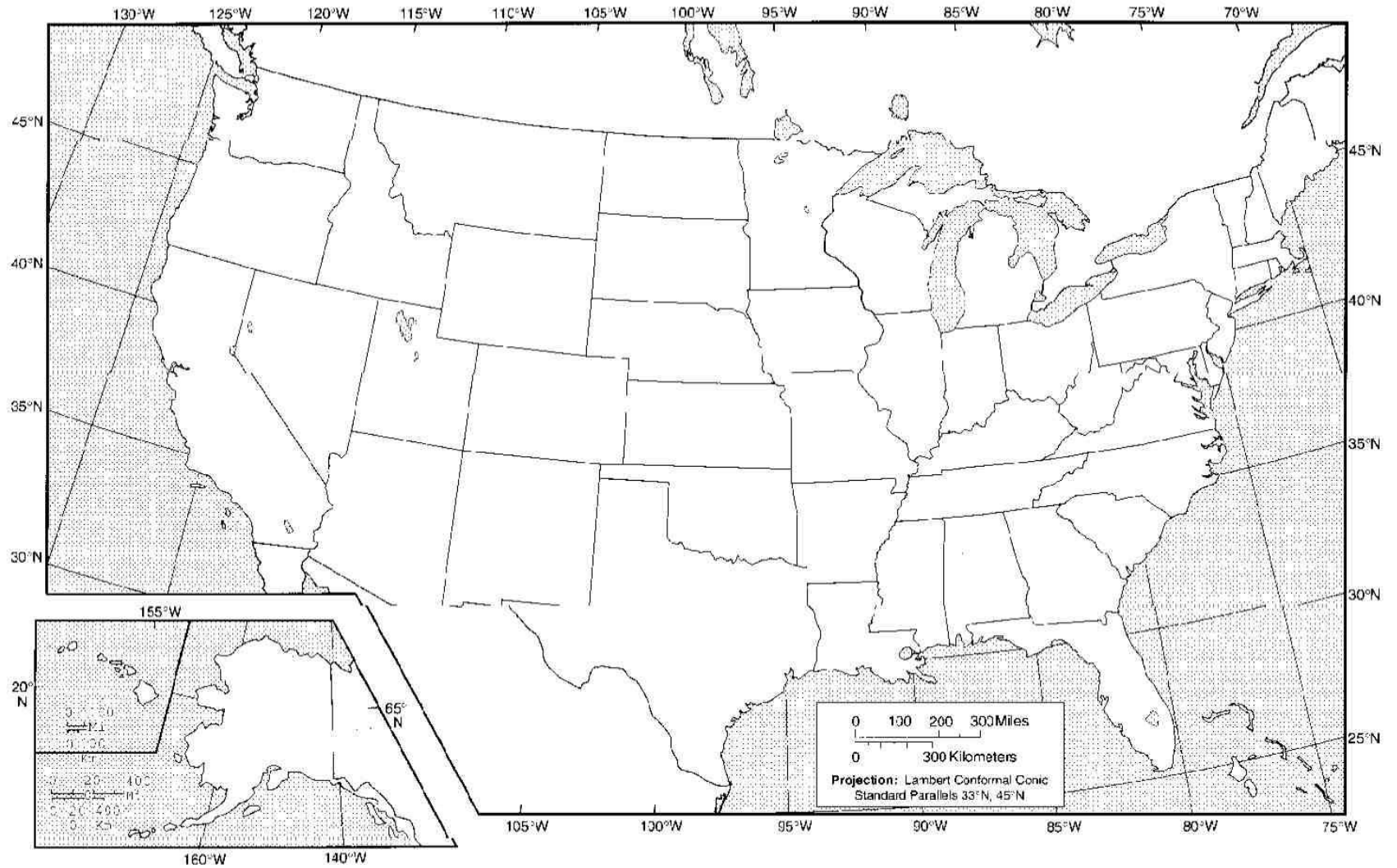
Objective

- Finally, on the back of the outline map, write a justification (in paragraph form) defending ALL of your choices. Also, if you divide a current state into two countries please explain why (for example: northern West Virginia and southern West Virginia are in two different countries).
