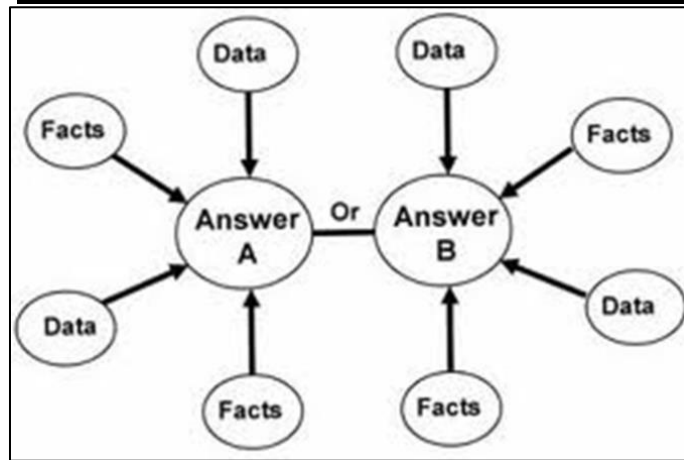

### Language Acquisition Stages

Age (Months)	Talent/Behavior/Stage
0-4 Months <i>In fantis</i> ("Not Speaking")	<b>Receptive</b> language: associating sounds with facial movements, and recognizing when sounds are broken into words
4 Months	<b>Productive</b> language: <b>babbling</b> in multilingual sounds and gestures
10 Months	<b>Babbling</b> sounds more like the parents'/household's language
12 Months	<b>One-word stage</b> : understanding and beginning to say many nouns
18-24 Months	<b>Two-word, "telegraphic"/tweet</b> speech: adding verbs, and making sentences but missing words ("See bird! Ree book? Go park!")
24+ months, 2+ Years	Speaking <b>full sentences</b> and understanding complex sentences
